FS 101: Trichoscopy: From Basic to Advanced

Description: This session will focus on when transplantation is appropriate in autoimmune alopecia.

FS 102: Transplantation to Areas Other Than Scalp

Description: This session will focus on transplanting into areas other than the scalp. The eyebrows, beard, and eyelashes are less common but cosmetically very important areas to the patient. These non-scalp areas are unique and require a specialized skillset to create a natural and long-lasting result. Experts in the field will be discussing overviews of design, patient selection, advanced techniques, and tips for success. Participants are encouraged to interact and share their thoughts and experiences in this specialized area of hair transplantation.

Updates of technologies (devices and punches) enable us to conduct complex preview long hair transplant procedures easily and get great results. And this session is all about how to fulfill it.

FS 111: Mega Cases in Hair Restoration 4000+ Graft Cases: How To Do It

Director: Bessam Farjo, MBChB, FISHRS | United Kingdom

Level: Intermediate – Advanced

Description: In certain patients, it may be desirable to achieve a particularly high number of harvested grafts, more than 4000 in one procedure. We shall discuss patient suitability, donor capacity and location, future hair loss issues and combining harvesting techniques. Our speakers will tell us about harvesting and implantation strategies to ensure a high survival rate, ergonomics during long cases, optimizing workflow to minimize surgery time, and combination of scalp, beard and body hair harvesting to achieve maximal total graft count.

FS 112: Nonsurgical Treatments: Updates on Noninvasive and Minimally Invasive Treatments for Hair Loss

Director: Nina Otberg, MD | Germany

Level: All levels

Description: This focus session centers around non-surgical approaches to treat androgenetic alopecia. Hair stimulating, advanced therapies for hair loss are key to a successful long term treatment outcome in hair restoration surgery and crucial for long term patient satisfaction. Noninvasive or minimally invasive medical, physical and cell based therapies will be discussed. The workshop emphasizes the importance, effectiveness and safety of treating androgenetic alopecia beyond hair restoration surgery.
