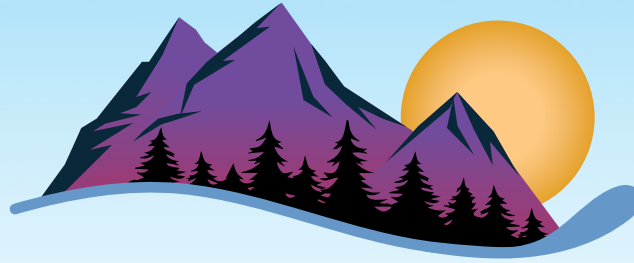

MESSAGE FROM THE PROGRAM CHAIR

Hello, and welcome to the 32nd World Congress in Denver! You have traveled from every corner of the globe to share in an immersive program that addresses the common bond that unites us as members of the ISHRS: a passion for hair restoration. This event promises to be an enriching learning experience, as well as an exceptional opportunity to meet new colleagues and expand our networks. For newcomers to our congress, this educational extravaganza provides the ideal venue from which to launch a

successful practice. For seasoned colleagues, we encourage you to pick up a few tips while gaining valuable insight and, importantly, we hope you will share your significant experience with others.

The invitation to be Program Chair of the 32nd World Congress arrived unexpectedly in July of last year. Our president, Brad Wolf, generously offered me this position and, after carefully considering my other commitments, I enthusiastically accepted. In his words, Brad stated that "the Chair needs to have a vision for the meeting, but also the flexibility and openness to understand the nuances that inevitably arise each year." Wise words indeed!

In addition to the three-day congress, several educational opportunities are scheduled before the start, allowing attendees to get the most out of their trip. On Tuesday, October 15, we will have the full-day **Live Surgery Workshop**, which provides both beginners and experienced physicians with an in-depth immersion in the practice of hair transplantation. The Basics and Advanced Courses follows on Wednesday, October 16, with that afternoon dedicated to the ½ Day Course exclusively focusing on Afro hair restoration.

To prepare the Congress program, we read close to 150 abstracts. These next were evaluated by the Scientific Committee, and their category chosen: CSI (this year, they are posters), Focused Session, or General Session. Just like assembling a puzzle, every piece must fit together to create a cohesive image, and my guiding principle has been to develop a program that embodies the exceptional level of science and artistry that establishes the ISHRS as the leading organization among all hair restoration societies.

The presentations showcase the diverse interests of our membership in the comprehensive study of the hair follicle, as well as the geographical richness of our speakers. Our five prestigious keynote speakers will address a range of topics that either expand our knowledge of the field or that bring new perspectives to our understanding of the hair. These include cutting-edge advancements in artificial intelligence and bioengineering and the psychological implications of a hair transplant. Panels and AR (audience response) will be seamlessly integrated to create a dynamic program. Eight focused sessions will provide an in-depth exploration of specific topics, encouraging attendees to stimulate lively discussions with faculty. Additionally, our traditional M&M Session and an unforgettable Live Patient Viewing will round out the event.

This year, I made it a point to invite our younger members to speak, and they will present alongside our experienced mentors. The audience will witness a miscellany of generations contributing to this tour de force. CANCELLATION/REFUND POLICY

PHOTO POLICY Conference attendees may take photographs during oral or poster presentations provided that the photographs are strictly for personal, noncommercial use, and not disruptive to the speaker or other learners.

VIDEO POLICY No video recording allowed.

CELLULAR PHONE POLICY The use of cellular phones in the General Session or workshop rooms is strictly prohibited. Attendees must either turn off or vibrate cellular phones.

WEATHER

October temperatures vary greatly in Denver, generally between 37°F and 68°F (3°C and 20°C) with three days of rain.

If you plan for pre- or post-outings up in the mountains, be prepared for cooler temperatures as it gets colder as you go up in elevation.

MEETING ATTIRE

The attire for the in-person educational sessions is business.

For this year's "ISHRS Rocky Mountain Rodeo" gala, attendees are encouraged to wear western-style attire including a Cowboy Tuxedo, western style dresses, cowboy boots, cowboy hat, big belt buckles, denim, etc.

BADGES

An official ISHRS-issued badge for the 32nd World Congress is required to enter the World Congress. Alterations and tampering with badges is prohibited and subject to the No Badge Swapping Policy.

Only those with a physician's badge will be permitted to attend education designated for physicians only.

BADGE REPRINT POLICY

A penalty fee of \$25 USD will be charged for the first reprint of lost or misplaced badges. A second reprint will incur a penalty fee of \$100 USD. Badges will not be printed a third time.

NO BADGE SWAPPING POLICY

You may not swap badges with other persons. Badges are issued to individuals for that individual's use, and only that individual's use. Replacement badges using another name or badge swapping is prohibited. Unauthorized use of Congress badges shall be subject to a \$2,000 USD fine per violation and punitive action by the Board of Governors, up to and including Congress ejection or possible forfeiture of ISHRS membership..

AIRPORT & GROUND TRANSPORTATION INFORMATION

The conference venue, the Sheraton Denver Downtown, is located 22 miles/35-45 minutes from Denver International Airport (airport code: DEN).

TAXI Taxis are available from the airport on Level 5, Island 1, outside doors 505, 507 and 511 (Terminal East) and Doors 506, 510 and 512 Terminal West).

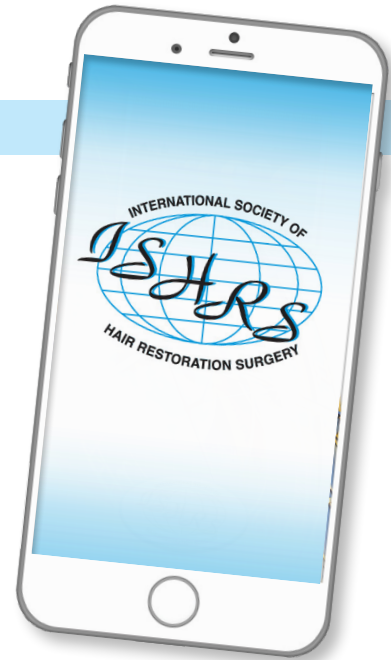
The taxi airport flat rate is the same for all taxi companies. The fare to and from Denver International Airport and downtown is a flat rate of \$66.00 USD + \$5.03 USD gate fee + \$5.00 USD for any additional drops. Confirm with your taxi driver that they will charge you this flat rate.

RIDE SHARE Ride share services like Uber and Lyft are available from Denver International Airport (DEN) from Level 5, Island 5.

AIRPORT TRAIN For \$10 each way, travelers can take the airport rail, known as the A Line, from DEN to Denver Union Station and vice versa. The Sheraton Denver Downtown is located one mile from Union Station. The 23-mile ride takes about 37 minutes. Board the train at the DEN Transit Center (look for the signs that say Transit Center instead of airport rail), Level 1, adjacent to the Westin Denver International Airport Hotel. Tickets can be purchased on rail line platforms at the ticket vending machines. The train from DEN to Denver Union Station runs every 15 minutes between 5:12AM and 7:27PM, and every 30 minutes outside of those hours.

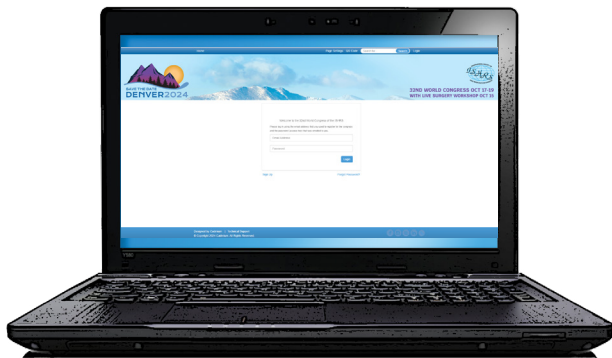

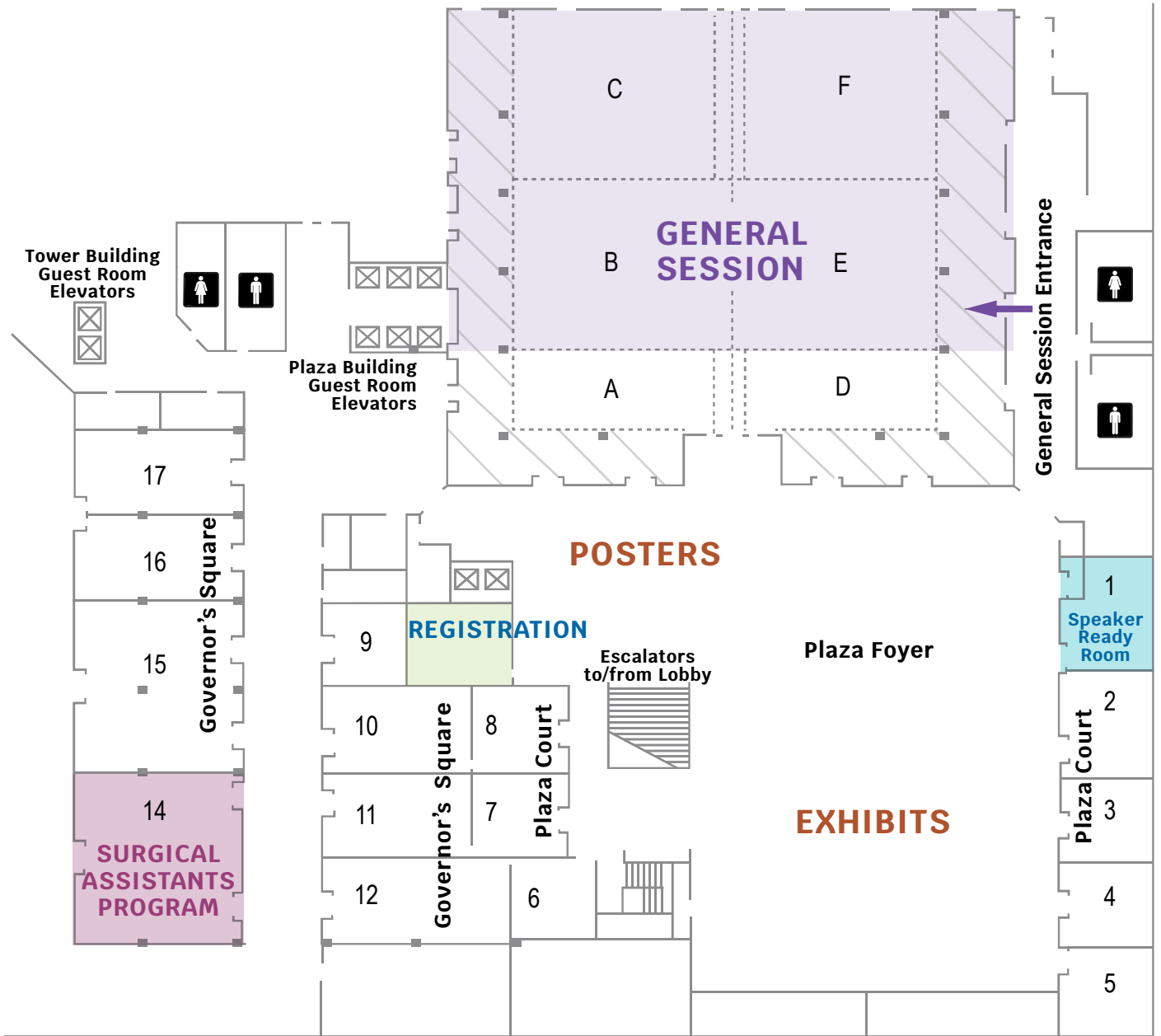

There will be four surgery demonstrations which will include the Mamba, WAW, and Zeus FUE harvest devices, as well as strip harvest and trichophytic closure technique. In addition to the harvest devices, we will have demonstrations of numerous graft implantation devices, such as sharp and blunt implanters and inserters.

ABOUT THE NORWOOD LECTURESHIP



O'Tar T. Norwood

The Norwood Lectureship pays tribute to O'Tar Norwood, MD, an Oklahoma physician who had a long and successful career in dermatology. At the time of writing his first book on Hair Transplant Surgery in 1973, he was Clinical Assistant Professor of Dermatology at the University of Oklahoma Medical School, USA. Amongst other things he was a Founding Member of the American Society

for Dermatologic Surgery and with Dr. Dow Stough he was instrumental in gathering like-minded doctors in 1992 to form the ISHRS. O'Tar was a restless thinker who brought together people and ideas to explain the MPHL process. His letters and communications were so numerous that he started a magazine called the Hair Transplant Forum International. It grew very quickly and became so popular that everyone wanted to read it and contribute articles. Soon after, O'Tar donated the magazine to the ISHRS. Its descendant is the ever-popular Forum we read today. O'Tar continued to publish and teach at our conferences for many years. His name is etched in our history. Those who knew O'Tar fondly remember the informal moments after lectures where his wit and joy for life were wonderful to share. He would welcome all with his cheeky warm smile.

ABOUT THE STOUGH LECTURESHIP



Dow B. Stough

The Stough Lectureship recognizes an individual with vision and a demonstrated passion for education. Established in 2019, the Stough Lecture honors ISHRS Co-founder Dow Stough, MD, who in the early 1990's recognized that the fractured, chaotic, and often secretive world of hair restoration needed an anchor. The founding of the ISHRS in 1993 brought order to chaos, turned competitors into

colleagues, and created an educational organization that has changed the face and improved the outcomes of hair restoration throughout the world. A very well-respected dermatologist from Hot Springs, Arkansas, USA, Dr. Stough was one of the earliest proponents of follicular unit transplantation and natural looking hairlines, and his focus on innovation and teaching is evidenced by Dow being the youngest President, Program Chair, Golden Follicle Award winner, and Manfred Lucas Award winner in ISHRS history. He is a true leader and his contagious enthusiasm has inspired and motivated many hair transplant surgeons. His knack for encouraging colleagues – newcomers and old-timers alike – to get involved, share knowledge, and ask questions, is perhaps his greatest legacy.

Pankaj Karande, PhD

Dr. Pankaj Karande is an Associate Professor in Chemical and Biological Engineering at Rensselaer Polytechnic Institute. He was awarded his B.S. in Chemical Engineering from Mumbai University Institute of Chemical Technology and his Ph.D. in Chemical Engineering from the University of California, Santa Barbara. Dr. Karande was awarded an Anna Fuller Postdoctoral Fellowship in Molecular Oncology, and he conducted postdoctoral research in the Center for Cancer Research at Massachusetts Institute of Technology before joining the faculty at Rensselaer. He has received a variety of awards and honors in his career, including the Excellence in Classroom Instruction Award and the Outstanding Teaching Award from Rensselaer Polytechnic Institute. He also received the Alzheimer's Association New Investigator Research Award, the Goldhirsh Brain Tumor Research Award, and a Bronze Edison Award in the Best New Product in Science and Medical Category.



In addition, he has been issued multiple patents in the areas of Transdermal Formulation Discovery and Novel High Throughput Screening Platforms. Over the last 15 years, Dr. Karande's research has focused on the use of 3d-bioprinting to engineer human skin for regenerative medicine and efficacy platforms. His group published some of the early and seminal papers in 3d-bioprinting of human skin which have been featured in scientific press and popular media.

Dr. Pirmez works both in private practice and at the hospital. In both settings, he dedicates himself exclusively to patients with different types of alopecia and other scalp disorders. His main focus is on clinical trichology, and his publications cover both scarring and non-scarring alopecia. He is also a co-author of the book "Hair and Scalp Treatments," which was originally published in English and later translated into Portuguese, Spanish, Russian, Mandarin, and Turkish. Dr. Pirmez frequently speaks at national and international conferences.

Dr. Pirmez has a special interest in trichoscopy. He is one of the founding members of the International Trichoscopy Society (ITS), currently serving as its president. He will host the World Congress of Trichoscopy in 2026 in Rio de Janeiro, Brazil. 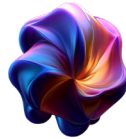

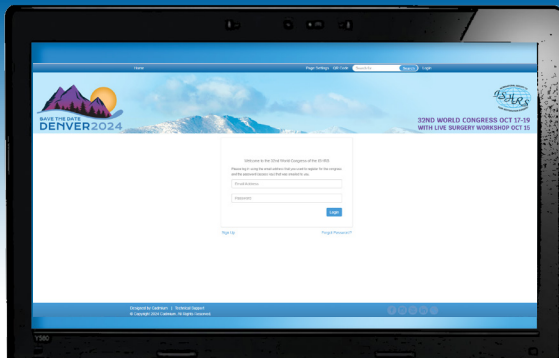

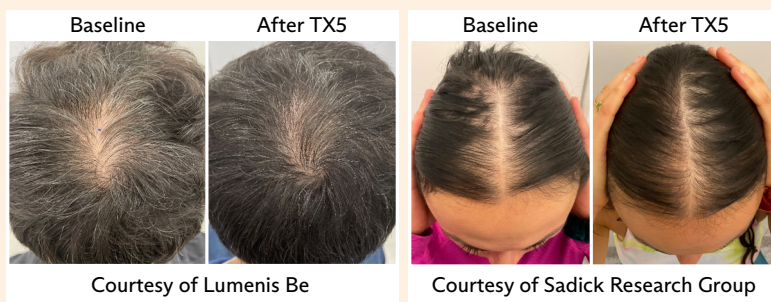
